#### Global Survey Report on the Future of Research Education in Universities

Enago, a global leader in editing and publication support services, recently conducted a comprehensive global survey on the Future of Research Education in the backdrop of COVID-19. This broad survey, which represents millions of students and thousands of faculty members, was conducted over 8 weeks between May and June 2020. A total of 108 universities spread across 38 countries.

The key learning from this survey is that a significant "paradigm shift" has occurred during the first half of 2020. A switch to online classrooms and elearning systems is widespread, adverse impact on research budgets is evident, overall uncertainty has risen, and a segment of universities has not found it easy to transition. However, the visible silver lining of the unprecedented global events is that the broad changes are likely to result in a more dynamic and progressive future of research education in universities in the medium to long term.




